DON'T FORGET!!!!

- Bring your year end report card. You will leave this report card with the secretary. If you submit your Year End report card at Huron, you do not need to bring one to Watertown.
- Bring your contestant back number.
- Calendar prize t-shirts and sweatshirts will be handed out at check in.
- All bull riding contestants must wear helmets approved for rodeo events.
- Stock will not be drawn for you if you have not registered by the end of check in.
- Contestants must be in full western attire** from one hour before performance until after the performance or if the contestant has won any awards, until after awards are picked up.
- Misuse of your horse by yourself as a contestant or any helper of a contestant – whether they are an adult or a minor – will not be tolerated. Should this happen, the person performing the action will be asked to leave the grounds and the Contestant may be disqualified. Keep the schooling of the horses in the practice pen, please.
