GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Position draw will be posted on <http://sdhsra.com/rodeos/regional-rodeos.html> shortly after entry deadline.
- You will need your contestant number to get through the gate without paying.
- Contestant positions will be drawn for each day.
- Contestant may draw the same livestock or position over the weekend of the regional rodeo as each performance is a separate rodeo.
- Misuse of your horse by yourself as a contestant or any helper of a contestant—whether they are an adult or a minor—will not be tolerated. Should this happen, the person performing the action will be asked to leave the grounds and the contestant may be disqualified. Keep the schooling of the horses in the practice pen, please.
- Pursuant to NHSRA Rule p. 36, 7(2), the SDHSRA Board of Directors has the authority to have the family member/guardian/parent/contestant removed from the grounds and/or disqualify the contestant from the rodeo and future rodeos. Adopted 2/8/2022
