



# South Dakota High School Rodeo Association Safety Policy



## CONTESTANT MEDICAL SAFETY:

Each REGIONAL OR PRACTICE RODEO must submit the activity approval form for the UPCOMING YEAR to the SDHSRA Secretary no later than December 15th.

The information provided on that form shall indicate the following:

1. Site of Rodeo – Specific address if possible.
2. Nearest Hospital or Urgent Care Facility
  - a. Address of Facility
  - b. Phone Number of Facility
3. Rodeo Producer
  - a. Phone Number
  - b. E Mail
4. RODEO SECRETARY
  - a. Address
  - b. Phone Number
  - c. E Mail

The forms will be collected by the SDHSRA Secretary and approved by the SDHSRA Board of Directors.

The SDHSRA requires that there be an ambulance on grounds at all SDHSRA and SDJHRA sanctioned rodeos. The ambulance must have an on board:

- Automatic External Defibrillator (AED)
- First Aid equipment
- Equipment necessary to maintain an emergency airway.

## ANIMAL SAFETY

Each Rodeo will post the SDHSRA Animal Safety Policy at either the contestant check-in area or horse stalling area, if one is designated.

The phone number of the nearest available Veterinarian will be posted by the Rodeo Secretary in the Rodeo Office and/or the designated horse stalling area.

## RODEO CONTESTANT SAFETY

A safety check that has been approved by the SDHSRA Board of Directors will be held prior to the rodeo for Rough Stock events and any other event deemed necessary by an SDHSRA Director or Rodeo Committee.
