Dear 20X High School Showcase Contestant,

Congratulations on being selected for the 2017 20X High School Showcase Rodeo Jan. 29th at 1:00 p.m. You accomplished this by finishing in the top three of your event, in your region, for the 2016 High School Rodeo season. This rodeo began in 2003 as a dream of my husband, Steve Sutton. He wanted to showcase the great talent we have in the SD High School Rodeo ranks during our PRCA Rodeo in Rapid City, SD. He wanted to see the SDHSR athletes compete in the same arena as the PRCA World Champions and SD Rodeo Legends.

Contestants enter at the NW entrance door of the Rushmore Plaza Civic Center, where there will be a contestant list with security. Contestant check-in begins at 10:30 am and ends at 11:30 am. The contestant meeting is at 11:30 & team picture will be taken at 11:45 am. Trailer parking is in the NW parking lot of the Civic Center. Contestants can ride in the arena from 8:00-10:00 am only. There are no stalls available at the Civic Center, but the Central States Fair does rent stalls out at the fairgrounds. Call Central States Fairgrounds for information and requirements to stall.

There is a \$20 entry fee per contestant which is due with the entry form. Event winners will receive a Ralph Maynard Trophy Buckle. Wrangler has sponsored shirts in the past and I anticipate this sponsorship for 2016, but make sure you bring a long sleeved shirt for competition if needed.

Tickets for family and friends can be purchased that day or in advance by calling the Rushmore Plaza Civic Center at 1-800-GOT-MINE. It is set as a General Admission Family Day performance, which means you can get 5 tickets for \$65.00 Balcony Rows 1-30 or \$15.00 per ticket. VIP floor section tickets are \$28.00 per ticket. If you need a helper in your event, you can pick up a helper's pass at check-in. The helper will have to purchase a ticket to the rodeo.

Please fill out the **biography sheet** and mail it with your **entry form** and **\$20 entry fee**. It's important for the rodeo announcer to have information to discuss while you compete.

If you are a **senior** and want to apply, the **scholarship application** must be filled out and returned with your entry form and bio sheet. We are anticipating four scholarships to be awarded, 2/500-2/1000. All forms are posted on the SDHSR website or call me and I will email directly to you.

Plans are being made for a college fair to be held from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. at the south end of the arena. This is for any age student and/or parent in high school rodeo and a great opportunity for you.

Finally, make sure you contact Sutton Rodeo **immediately** if you are not going to enter or can't compete after you have entered so we can contact the alternates and give them the opportunity to prepare for competition. If I have not received your entry by the deadline you will have to provide me with a copy of the original notarized entry form and "proof of mailing" or you will be withdrawn from the rodeo. ## 20X EXTREME RODEO SHOWCASE 2017

**Purpose:** To showcase South Dakota High School rodeo talent.

**Selection Criteria:**

1. To be invited to compete, you must be in the top three places on points at the end of the 2016 SDHSR season in your competed region. This is based on the year end point total from regions and state.
2. Three students will be invited from each region in each event.
3. Incoming freshmen are not eligible, nor is a student who did not earn any points in the 2016 SDHS rodeo season.
4. Students must be a current member of SDHSRA for the 2017 season. If you have been invited, but have not paid your membership dues, you will be drawn out of the rodeo.
5. Students will be invited to compete in one event only.
6. If a student places in the top 3 in more than one event, invitation will be in the event the student has the **most** points in.
7. Team Roping - Top 3 teams in each region will be invited. If any team is missing a partner, it will be filled by rolling down to the next highest point header or heeler. The roper invited will be determined by the need of the above roper, who is in the top 3 positions. For example: The top team in the region is missing a header. The 2nd and 3rd teams are complete. The 4th place header will be invited to rope with the 1st place heeler. If he/she declines, the next highest point header will be invited.
8. Tie-Breakers - If there is a tie at the 3rd place position in an event, it will be broken:
  - A) 1st - The highest number of times a student earned points in that event.  
For example: If Steve won 1st for 10 points and Brent won 2nd twice for 10 points, Brent would win the tiebreaker.
  - B) 2nd - The highest number of times placed at regional rodeos.
  - C) 3rd - The highest number of times placed at state finals.
  - D) 4th - The highest placing in that event.
  - E) 5th - Flip of a coin.
