\$4,000 available in Don Hight Memorial Scholarships!

As a Senior SDHSRA member, if you compete in the White River High School Practice Rodeo on May 25, 2018, you will be eligible to apply for a 2018 Don Hight Memorial Scholarship.

Don Hight ranched between White River and Murdo, SD along with his wife Adeline, where they raised cattle, buffalo, and a string of “rank bucking horses and nasty bucking bulls” for the rodeo circuit. In 1962, Don captured the world’s attention by trailing 1,800 head of cattle from Westover to Winner, SD, a distance of 70 miles. Shortly after, Don was featured in an episode of the Rawhide TV series. But above all, Don was an avid supporter of all things rodeo.

With gratitude from an anonymous donor who appreciates the support given by Don Hight to the sport of rodeo, and who also wants to extend that support to the future endeavors of today’s rodeo youth, \$4000 in scholarships will be awarded to six contestants at this year’s White River High School Practice Rodeo.

1st place: \$1,000 scholarship

2nd place: \$800 scholarship

3rd and 4th place: \$600 scholarship to each

5th and 6th place: \$500 scholarship to each

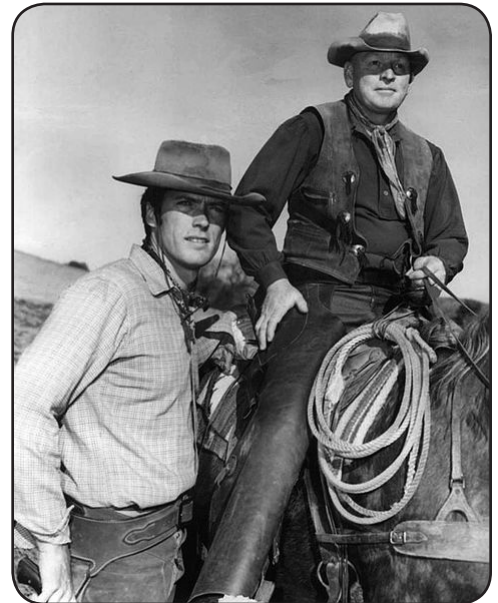
Requirements for eligibility:

- 1) You must attend any college, university or tech school in the Fall 2018 semester (any major is accepted - this scholarship is not exclusive to ag degrees) upon your graduation from high school in 2018. You do not have to rodeo in college.
- 2) You must be a current member of the South Dakota High Rodeo Association.
- 3) You must attend and compete in at least one event at the 2018 White River High School Practice Rodeo, as sponsored by the Michael Glynn Memorial Coalition (May 25, 2018).
- 4) You must write an essay of any length, telling of your experience in the sport of rodeo: for example, what led you to want to rodeo, how it has impacted your life already, how you plan to use what you have learned through rodeo in the rest of the your life.

The Board of Directors of the Michael Glynn Memorial Coalition will judge all applications.

Applications for this scholarship must be received by the Michael Glynn Memorial Coalition prior to May 11, 2018. Scholarship recipients will be announced during the White River High School Practice Rodeo. Recipients must be available that day for pictures.

In the event a winner does not compete in the WRHS practice rodeo, an alternate will be awarded his/her scholarship. In the event a recipient does not enroll in an institution of higher learning for the Fall 2018 semester, an alternate will be selected to receive his/her scholarship award.
