GENERAL INFORMATION:

- ✓ Position draw will be posted on http://sdhsra.com/regional_rideo_results.htm shortly after entry deadline.
- ✓ You will need your contestant number to get through the gate without paying.
- ✓ Admission: Children ages 11 and under: admitted free when accompanied by an adult
Ages 12 and over: \$12 wristband for two days OR \$7 per performance
- ✓ Contestant positions will be drawn for each day.
- ✓ Contestant may draw the same livestock or position over the weekend of the regional rodeo as each performance is a separate rodeo.
- ✓ Misuse of your horse by yourself as a contestant or any helper of a contestant—whether they are an adult or a minor—will not be tolerated. Should this happen, the person performing the action will be asked to leave the grounds and the contestant may be disqualified. Keep the schooling of the horses in the practice pen, please.
- ✓ **New rule:** In the tie-down roping event, a contestant will receive no-time for that run if he brings the animal over backwards (between 10 and 2 on a standard clock) with the animal landing on his back or head with all four feet in the air.
- ✓ **Awards:** Awards will be given for both Saturday and Sunday, as well as a high point buckle for the weekend. If there should be a tie in any event for the high point buckle, the tie will be broken with either the fast time or high score.
