Justin Cowboy Crisis Fund Basket

Hello Everyone:

It's a new year and a new rodeo season, which means time to think about donating items to the Justin Cowboy Crisis Fund Basket. The "basket", often confused for being a "queen's basket", consists of donated items taken by our state team to Nationals High School Finals. The basket is placed among the baskets donated by other state teams and is used to raise money for the Crisis Fund. These baskets are auctioned off during a silent auction that runs throughout the course of the week. The money is then donated to the Crisis Fund, which is a fund set up to help any individual injured while competing in a sanctioned High School Rodeo. This money raised would be available to a South Dakota team member if they were to become injured.

The baskets consist of many items ranging anywhere from jewelry donated by local western vendors to blankets and clothing items. Last year the basket to hold the items was donated by the Southwest region, which was a cedar chest made by Cow Creek Cedar. Items in the basket consisted of T-shirts, jewelry donated by vendors from the 2008 SHDSRA Finals Rodeo, a pheasant hunt, western glasses, as well as many other items donated by numerous vendors and sponsors. Any item will be accepted for the basket.

Each year the board of directors asks that each club donate an item to the basket. This year the River Region donating the "basket" itself, and is responsible for getting it to Nationals. Individuals who are not part of a club are also encouraged to make a donation to the Crisis Fund Basket.

Our 2009 rodeo seasons is soon approaching us, which means we can all get started early this year and make a donation to the 2009 Justin Cowboy Crisis Fund Basket. Items should be dropped off in the office during the 2009 State Finals Rodeo.

Until next month, I hope everyone is enjoying the nice weather and hitting the practice pen as the 2009 season will be here before we know it!!

You must have presented your final report card to compete the second weekend. The only change is that the report cards will be kept.
