IT'S MEMBERSHIPTIME

With this newsletter you will find the information that you need for your 2007-2008 Membership forms.

**You need to fill out the National Form and make sure that on the back side your notary LISTS all three of you where the line is that you personally appeared. You need 3 signatures on the front, 3 on the back and all 3 of your names listed or the National Office will send it back to me to be returned to you. If you have a parent that is deceased or have full custody, indicate that in their name line.

- ** Fill out the South Dakota Form and have your principal sign the form.
- ** Enclose your most current mid term report or report card.
- **Enclose a money order or cashiers check for \$128.00 if you are a competing member.

MEMBERSHIPS ARE DUE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 1ST

You must rodeo in the region that your school is listed in on the rules and regulations page of the website.

If you have a membership coming for last year's calendar sales, just enclose a note along with your membership instead of a check.

Reminder--Memberships are due December 1st!!

ALL SDHSRA MEMBERS <u>MUST</u> SELL <u>3 SDHSRA</u> CALENDARS BY <u>MARCH 1ST</u> OF THE CURRENT YEAR. THE MONEY AND STUBS MUST BE TURNED IN TO SARA GRIM (POSTMARKED) ON OR BEFORE MARCH 1ST. ALL SDHSRA MEMBERS MUST ALSO RETURN ANY UNSOLD CALENDARS BY MARCH 1ST OR THEY WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO RODEO.

This past year, the 2006-2007 season, 5379 calendars were sold. 183 members received Tshirts, 91 received caps, 74 received coats, and 1 buckle and 20 memberships were awarded. Six members earned scholarships. The National Team qualifiers each received \$1000.

When you check out calendars from the contact person, make sure you have the amount of calendars you want to sell. You can check out 20 calendars at a time. But remember, you sell them, return them or you pay for them. It might be better to take a few, sell them, send the stubs in and then get more calendars. The list of Calendar Contact persons is on the website. If there is no one close to your location, you can contact Sara Grim direct and arrangements will be made to get calendars out to you.
