- Bring your contestant back number.

- All bull riding contestants must wear helmets approved for rodeo events.
- Stock will not be drawn for you if you have not registered by the end of check in.
- CONTESTANTS MUST BE IN FULL WESTERN ATTIRE** from one hour before performance until after the performance and must be in western attire to pick up awards.
- Misuse of your horse by yourself as a contestant or any helper of a contestant – whether they are an adult or a minor – will not be tolerated. Should this happen, the person performing the action will be asked to leave the grounds and the Contestant may be disqualified. Keep the schooling of the horses in the practice pen, please.
