- You will need your contestant number to get through the gate without paying.
- Contestant positions are drawn for each day.
- Contestants may draw the same livestock or position over the weekend of the regional rodeo as each performance is a separate rodeo.
- Misuse of your horse by yourself as a contestant or any helper of a contestant—whether they are an adult or a minor—will not be tolerated. Should this happen, the person performing the action will be asked to leave the grounds and the contestant may be disqualified. Keep the schooling of the horses in the practice pen, please.
